


Sailing Holidays and Voyages on board the Schooner Trinovante for 2021

This year's itinerary allows plenty of time to sail relatively short distances compared to Trinovante's previous schedules. The focus will be on using the engine as little as possible, visiting seaside ports and simply enjoying being out on the water again. All the ports have a train station within walking distance apart from Brixham where the nearest station is five miles away in Paignton. You'll need to catch a bus or taxi from there.

UK Taster Weekend	Sailing to and from Ipswich Dock Trinovante sails in her home waters on the Thames Estuary rivers, the Orwell, Stour, Colne, and Blackwater plus some coastal sailing too. The focus is on learning as much as possible about sailing a schooner in a relaxed and friendly environment. Usually, we spend the last night in the historic old port of Harwich. UK Sailing	Coastal/OverNight Day Sailing	Ipswich to Littlehampton	
Sail from Ipswich threading through the sand banks of the Thames Estuary to round North Foreland and head down channel past the white cliffs of Dover. Littlehampton is a historic port where the well known classic Hillyard yachts were built up until the 1970's. Before that Littlehampton had a long history of building brigs and schooners for trade. Places we may stop overnight are Ramsgate, Dover, Brighton, and Newhaven. Possible anchorages include the Swale and Dungeness. It is likely there will be night sailing or an overnight passage on this leg. Sea miles 200			Sat 24 th July to Sat 31 st July 7 Nights £945
UK Sailing	Coastal Day Sailing	Littlehampton to Brixham	
This leg sets sail from Littlehampton past the Isle of Wight, sailing either inside through the Solent or outside past St Catherines Point. Hopefully we will get a good view of the Needles as we sail past. Then we will need to pick time and tide carefully to round Portland Bill and avoid the notorious Portland race before sailing across Lyme Bay to the attractive Devon fishing port of Brixham. Places we might call into include Portsmouth, Poole and Weymouth. Possible anchorages include Osborne Bay below Osborne House one of Queen Victoria's favourite residences or Hurst Roads near the Needes. It is likely there will be night sailing or an overnight passage on this leg. Sea Miles 165			Sat 7 th August to Sat 14 th August 7 Nights £945

<p>UK Sailing Coastal Day and Overnight Sailing Brixham to Ipswich If passage making is more your thing this is the leg for you. Depending on the wind we may spend more or less time on the South Coast or in the Thames Estuary. Places we might call into include Weymouth, Poole, Portsmouth, Littlehampton, Brighton, Newhaven, Dover, Brighton, Ramsgate and Harwich. <p>UK Sailing Coastal Day Sailing Ipswich to London Set sail from the centre of Ipswich to sail in the rivers of the East Coast before heading towards an anchorage off Southend. <p>What is included in these prices? All food and non-alcoholic drinks onboard, use of life-jackets, and wet weather gear. What is not included in these prices? Trinovante is not a dry ship but we don't allow drinking alcohol whilst sailing or about to sail.
